

*The following is a speech by Shan Ju Lin, a Taiwanese born candidate for the Federal seat of Moreton in Queensland Australia. It gives Australian voters food for thought when assessing the policies of political parties and the threat from the Chinese Communist Party (CCP).*

Good evening Ladies & Gentlemen,

I was born in Taiwan, and was fortunate to migrate to Australia in 1991. I've embraced my new country, earning a Masters of Education, getting involved with community groups, and taking the opportunity to put back in.

Living in Australia is like winning the lottery of life. We have a pristine environment, freedom of speech and political activity (and here I am!), healthcare for all, and you can even own land. Australia is called "the lucky country" and I'd believe it. But this unrivaled dose of 'the good life' we have become accustomed to comes with a hidden cost.

We've never had significant turmoil on our own soil. Just as "still waters make for poor sailors", we've grown dangerously lazy when it comes to freedom and ensuring our future.

You've probably heard "foreign investment" touted as vital to our country as it enables larger projects and job creation. But remember: nobody invests like that without expecting it to pay for itself, and also generate a return. You wouldn't do that either. Thus, our wealth flows out of the country.

Having lived in tiny Taiwan with its mere 24 million people (same as here) and under the shadow of China, I'm now alerting you to a threat I can see - but you won't have realised - due to the differences in how we think.

The people here can not possibly sense the danger we are in ... and so the rest of us are kept in the dark.

Australians believe in a fair go. The ruling communist party of China doesn't bother with fair. They don't have our interests at heart. Neither do they practice the freedoms I mentioned earlier. Say the wrong thing and you can literally have your tongue cut out. End up in jail, and you're automatically on the organ donor list ... as the donor. Temples are built, but only so party officials can keep the money offerings for themselves.

The CCP mindset is to take over the world through a very real economic kind of war. They will

engage our companies with the promise of access to Chinese markets and big profits, but walk away the moment they have the technology they want.

You may not be aware that all major Chinese companies are allowed to exist at the will of the CCP. Any Chinese company is essentially a state company. We're selling them the best of our food producing land which then comes under their control. There is also considerable residential and commercial real estate sold to China.

We even sold them the Ports of Darwin and Newcastle! Our allies in the American navy can't figure out why, either!

Melbourne and Freemantle ports are about to be sold.

The Chinese are very good at attracting and setting up people, but they are the biggest scammers in the world. In China, being 'tricky' is seen as being 'clever'. They will get what they can, and then continue to use their money to influence our politics for their needs.

Our way of life is at stake. Please consider.

I want you to know that I fully support the traditional family values of people here, and I am against abortion. China has had an aggressive one child policy with forced abortions and now they are facing their own demographic collapse. They won't have enough young people to keep going. It's a Darwin Award for an entire nation.

It makes no sense then to voluntarily throw away our unborn, thus preventing childless couples from adopting, and forcing them to play the hideously expensive IVF lottery instead.

It makes even less sense to deliberately create sterile couples who are incapable of contributing new members to our community. So naturally I am against same sex marriage.

As you can tell, I refuse to submit to the cowardice of 'political correctness.' There is too much at stake.

I'm Shan Ju Lin, I'm prepared to say what must be said, and I will definitely stand up for the people of Moreton.
