

The biggest political "tiger" - a corrupt top official - in the history of the People's Republic of China is about to be caged.

Zhou Yongkang, the former internal head of security, member of the politburo and part of the Jiang Zemin political faction will soon be arrested and face trial for corruption.

Zhou was instrumental in carrying out Jiang Zemin's persecution of Falun Gong practitioners along with Bo Xilai, Luo Gan, and other members of the faction. These three men in particular, are responsible for the killing of Falun Gong practitioners for their organs, but this is unlikely to come out at Zhou's public trial as the communist regime cannot admit to its complicity without bringing down the regime itself.

Communist party leader Xi Jinping is using the trials of high profile 'tigers' such as Zhou and Bo Xilai to deflect attention from the regime's problems and to build his own power base.
