

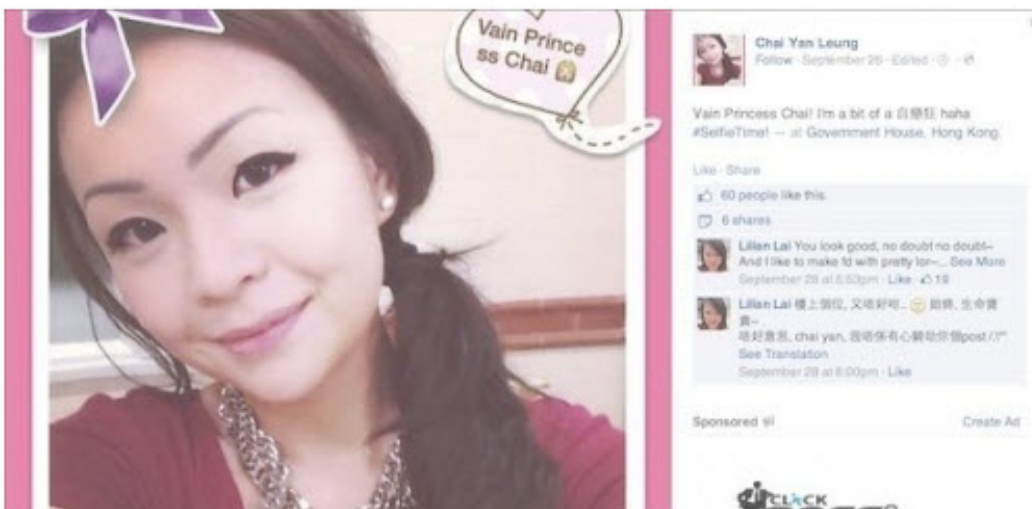
My Beautiful Dresses, Shoes...Funded By You Taxpayers!
